Hamilton East Kiwanis Non-Profit Homes Inc. (Kiwanis Homes) is pleased to announce that we are accepting applications from the general public for a new Pilot Affordable Homeownership Initiative.

Hamilton's skyrocketing real estate market makes home ownership a distant dream for many people. In partnership with the City of Hamilton, Hamilton Community Foundation, Home Ownership Alternatives and FirstOntario Credit Union, a new program from Kiwanis Homes seeks to put this dream within reach for many in our community.

Kiwanis Homes has been providing affordable housing in Hamilton since 1982. Recently, it has turned its focus to raising capital for additional housing by helping current renters become homeowners. Each partner's investment will create a shared appreciation mortgage pool, an innovative way to assist the buyers in qualifying for a first mortgage, one of the most significant barriers to homeownership for low to middle-income people. When the initial mortgage matures, owners can opt to sell their homes or renegotiate, with the partners sharing the appreciation.

To qualify for participation in the program, purchasers must meet the following criteria:

- Their gross family income must not exceed \$113,600 per year.
- They must provide a minimum downpayment of five percent of the home's appraised value.
- They must qualify for a mortgage from a financial lending institution of a value of no less than fifty-five percent of the home's appraised value.

*"Too many Hamiltonians are unable to see themselves owning their own homes. Too many young people are living with their parents because rents are unaffordable, while others are paying sky-high rents that prevent them from saving for a down-payment. This is part of the housing crisis we face and solutions to that crisis require collaboration and partnership between the City and many organizations in our community. That is why today's announcement by Hamilton East Kiwanis Non-Profit Homes, in partnership with the City of Hamilton, Hamilton Community Foundation, Home Ownership Alternatives and FirstOntario Credit Union, is such welcome news. By reducing the barriers of affordability, this program has the potential of giving Hamiltonians back their dream of home ownership and making that dream a reality while contributing to a more healthy and affordable housing market overall."*
